## PROJECT UPDATE

### Progress

Once again we had great weather this week, and as a result we can all see progress. The landscaping continued. I've had several questions about why some trees were removed and new ones brought in. It was because the landscape architect comes to inspect the work and when something is either not meeting the quality standard or is not the right type, they then have the contractor make the changes.

At Martin Health Center, if you've driven by you've seen siding and brickwork continue. Inside, the interior wall framing on the second floor is nearly complete, the overhead rough-ins for mechanical, electrical and plumbing are in progress and the first story roof materials have been received. At the service entrance the drywall finishing has begun as has the exterior gutters and downspouts.

### Looking Ahead

At Martin Health Center over the next two weeks, the interior wall framing on the first floor will be done, the exterior siding will continue, the mechanical, electrical and plumbing rough-ins and roofing will be done. A new generator is being placed near Martin Health Center and the pad for that generator will be poured right after Christmas.

The service entrance will have interior finish work the week of Christmas and will be complete just after the new year. The week of Christmas the contractors will work Tuesday through Friday, and the week of New Year's they will do the same so they can enjoy holidays with their families.

**Of Note:** Work will be done in the new entrance area, offices and salon addition to balance the heating and cooling HVAC system. This work will begin early on Friday, December 22 and be concluded that day. There will not be a construction meeting the week of Christmas so this will serve as your update for two weeks.
