Progress

There certainly has been a lot accomplished and I'm beginning to wonder if I will be able to capture everything that has been going on into relatively short memos each week. This past week, the membrane roofing was completed at the MPR addition and begun at the salon. Steel erection continued around the entrance and steel erection began at Martin Health Center. If you've not seen the area around Martin Health Center, it is worth taking a walk over to peek out of the windows. It is amazing how quickly they are moving.

They applied air and vapor barrier at the additions and have completed the exterior insulation at the MPR. For the new entrance off Mercer, grading is in process as is the site electrical work.

Upcoming Construction Work

At the front entrance, they will continue the grading and the site electrical work. The second phase of the southeast parking lot for Building 1 will begin as the new area is complete. Steel erection will continue at Martin Health Center and will be completed for the entrance addition. Exterior sheathing will begin at the entrance area and roofing will begin at dining.

The small air conditioning units in the Arts and Crafts Room will have to be removed for the roofing of the dining area. We are putting a spot cooler in this area and do not anticipate having any problems with temperature.

Within the next two weeks you will see siding going on several of the additions and window installation. You may even see some of the stone veneer being applied as work truly is moving at a fast pace.

Safety

The workers on site are doing an excellent job watching out for all of us and trying to provide for our safety. If you see things that we could improve, such as areas that need to be cleaned up, that have loose gravel or dirt build-up, please do not hesitate to let us know how we can continue to improve.
