News and updates on the Coronavirus and precautions are continuous. We here at Westminster Village continue to be committed to putting every precaution and guideline into place.

For your information, beginning yesterday afternoon, we have started screening all employees and vendors that enter Westminster. They are screened by temperature and symptoms. This will continue every shift until further notice.

In Martin Health Center and Assisted Living, all visitors from the outside are being screened by temperature, symptoms and questionnaire. Visitors under age 18 are being restricted in Martin Health Center.

As I'm sure you know, we are not a polling place next Tuesday, but we give thanks to the Bloomington Election Commission who has sent judges today, March 12, so that you can exercise your right to vote and not have to leave the community for that.

We are thankful for but cancelling outside speakers and volunteers as we are trying to limit the number of persons from the community who interact with residents at Westminster.

Of course, we are in this together. We would ask that you limit, if possible, your interactions outside of Westminster Village and that you keep visitors to a minimum. This is your home and we respect that but right now we are focused on protecting all to the greatest extent that we can. It's very possible that we will learn that the incidence of this virus has increased dramatically as testing becomes more available.

All of the standard precautions that we take for Influenza are to be followed for that and for the Coronavirus. Wash your hands, use hand sanitizer when soap and water are not available, keep a distance from others, do not shake hands, keep hands away from face, stay in if you are ill, and let us know how we can help you.

We will continue to update you as guidelines and practice changes.
