Once again, we do not have any positive cases to report on our campus at this time. We have received very positive feedback from the recent changes to visitation in Martin Health Center, Assisted Living and Memory Care. We are cautiously watching both the statewide and county reports that are indicating an uptick in the positivity rate as it could have an impact on mitigation steps we would be required to take.
